Any 1G SD-WAN device imported from Kenya must comply with Kenya's CAK Type Approval and KEBS standards to ensure legal importation and market access.

Regulatory Requirements

CAK Type Approval: The Communications Authority of Kenya (CAK) mandates that all Short Range Devices (SRDs) and Wireless LAN (WLAN) equipment, including SD-WAN devices operating in the 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz bands, must obtain Type Approval certification before importation, distribution, or use in Kenya. This applies even to low-power or license-exempt devices, and enforcement is strict, with non-compliant devices subject to shipment rejection, fines, or seizure (Web results).

KEBS Standards and Certification: The Kenya Bureau of Standards (KEBS) oversees product standards and may require a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) for imported devices. If a CoC from the country of origin is unavailable, destination inspection fees apply, ranging from 0.6% of the customs value (minimum \$265, maximum \$2,700), excluding sampling and testing fees. KEBS certification ensures compliance with safety, EMC, and technical standards, which is critical for SD-WAN devices that handle network traffic (Web result).

Import Process

- o **Verify CAK Approval:** Check the official CAK Type Approved Equipment List to confirm that the specific SD-WAN model is certified. If not listed, the manufacturer must submit technical documentation, test reports (often aligned with ETSI or CE standards), and at least one physical sample for inspection (Web results).
- o **Obtain KEBS CoC:** Ensure the device has a valid CoC or arrange for destination inspection. This step is essential to clear customs and avoid delays.
- o **Customs Clearance:** Submit all documentation, including CAK Type Approval certificate, KEBS CoC, and commercial invoices, to Kenyan customs. Non-compliance can result in shipment rejection or financial penalties.

Practical Considerations

- o Devices with CE markings or prior international certifications may have a smoother approval process.
- o SD-WAN devices that include wireless modules (Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, or IoT connectivity) must comply with frequency band regulations and may require additional testing.
- o Engage a local regulatory consultant or authorized agent to facilitate CAK and KEBS approvals, especially for first-time imports.
