- o Mechanical Splicing: This method aligns fibers physically using a sleeve and index-matching gel. It is faster and suitable for temporary connections or quick repairs, with slightly higher signal loss (around 0.3 dB). Mechanical splicing is often used for short-haul or emergency installations .
