They are manufactured to withstand mechanical loads and environmental conditions, making them ready for installation without further modification.

Components and Finishes

Support elements include wall brackets, suspended supports, and center suspensions. They are typically pre-finished to prevent corrosion and ensure durability in industrial or commercial environments. The finishes are selected based on the installation environment, for example:

- o Hot-dip galvanized steel for indoor and outdoor corrosion protection
 - o Stainless steel (AISI 316L) for highly corrosive environments
 - o Aluminum with natural oxide layer for lightweight and corrosion resistance
- These finishes are applied during manufacturing, so the supports are delivered as complete, ready-to-use products.

Installation Readiness

Vertical supports are designed to interface directly with cable trays and fittings, including vertical bends, T-pieces, and crossovers. They are supplied with the necessary mounting holes, brackets, and sometimes pre-assembled components, allowing for quick and safe installation . Accessories such as mounting plates or junction box supports are also considered part of the finished support system.
