Connecting Fiber to Your Router

- o Install the Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Your ISP provides an ONT that converts the fiber signal to Ethernet.
- o Connect the fiber cable: Plug the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet into the ONT.
- o Link ONT to router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to your router's WAN port.
- o Power on devices: Turn on the ONT and router, and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection .

- o Wi-Fi Standard: Wi-Fi 6 or 7 is recommended for speeds above 1 Gbps and for handling multiple devices efficiently .
