Overview of Cable Tray Reducers

Cable tray reducers are specialized components used to connect cable trays of different widths, ensuring a safe and efficient transition for cables. They prevent cable strain, maintain system stability, and allow for flexible routing in complex electrical installations . Reducers are essential when a cable tray system requires a change in width or direction, helping to maintain continuous cable flow without compression or tension .

Reduction Scale and Dimensions

Reducers are available for light, medium, and heavy-duty cable tray systems, with widths ranging from 50mm to 900mm . Common reduction scales are expressed as the difference between the larger and smaller tray widths, for example:

- o 6" x 6" to 4" x 4"
- o 6" x 6" to 3" x 3"
- o 4" x 6" to 4" x 4" These scales indicate the degree of reduction and are selected based on the number of cables, load requirements, and available space .

Types of Reducers

- o Left-hand and right-hand reducers: Used to direct cable flow to the left or right side of the tray system. Part numbers are modified to indicate orientation (e.g., CTLR for left-hand, CTRR for right-hand), .
- o 90-degree reducers: Facilitate sharp turns, often transitioning from horizontal to vertical layouts .
- o Sloped reducers: Gradually reduce tray width to minimize cable stress during transitions .

Materials and Finishes

Reducers are manufactured in various materials to suit environmental and load conditions:

- o Mild steel pre-galvanized (PG)
- o Mild steel hot-dip galvanized (HDG)
- o Stainless steel grade 1.4404 (316L), with optional chemical cleaning and passivation for corrosion resistance .

Installation Considerations

When selecting a reducer, consider:

- o Cable volume and type: Ensure the reduced tray can accommodate all cables without overcrowding.
- o System load: Heavy-duty systems may require reinforced reducers.
- o Orientation and slope: Choose left-hand, right-hand, or sloped reducers to match the tray layout.
- o Environmental conditions: Stainless steel is preferred for corrosive or outdoor environments .
