Overview

Marking and Measuring

- o Measure precisely using a sturdy tape measure to determine the required length or opening location .
- o Mark the cut line clearly with a permanent marker or chalk, ensuring it is straight and visible .
- o Double-check measurements to avoid errors that could compromise fit or alignment.

Cutting Techniques

- o Hand Grinder: Ideal for metal trays, providing smooth, precise cuts when used with proper technique and safety precautions .
- o Sawing: Hacksaws or power saws with metal-cutting blades are suitable for steel or aluminum trays .
- o Drilling and Punching: Used to create holes or openings for conduit pass-throughs or mounting brackets .
- o Cable Cutters: Heavy-duty cutters can be used for smaller aluminum or copper components within the tray system . Always select the tool based on tray material (steel, aluminum, fiberglass) and thickness to ensure clean cuts and minimize sharp edges.

Blanking and Edge Treatment

After cutting, smooth the edges to prevent injury and avoid cable damage. This can be done using a file, deburring tool, or grinder. Blanking plates may be installed to cover unused openings, maintaining safety and compliance with electrical codes .

Safety Precautions

- o Wear personal protective equipment: gloves, safety glasses, and hearing protection .
- o Secure the tray firmly before cutting to prevent movement.
- o Follow manufacturer guidelines for cutting intervals and after-treatment to maintain tray strength and performance .

o Ensure proper ventilation when using power tools to avoid inhaling metal dust.

Best Practices

o Plan cuts according to approved shop drawings to maintain alignment and clearance for cable pulling .
o Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports to prevent warping before installation .
