

Cable tray installation at a construction site in Ethiopia

Cable tray installation in Ethiopia requires adherence to ESA and IEC standards, proper material selection, and structured installation procedures to ensure safety and durability.

Overview of Cable Tray Systems in Ethiopia

Ethiopia's cable tray market is growing due to industrial expansion, energy projects like the Grand Ethiopian Renaissance Dam, and nationwide electrification initiatives. Most systems are imported, primarily from China, India, and Turkey, with local manufacturing limited (). Common materials include hot-dip galvanized steel, aluminum alloy, and fiberglass-reinforced polymer (FRP), chosen based on corrosion resistance and load requirements (). Industrial zones in Addis Ababa, Hawassa, and Dire Dawa show concentrated demand, while emerging regions like Tigray and Amhara are expanding ().

Material Selection

- o Hot-dip galvanized steel: Optimal for most regions, providing corrosion protection ().
- o 316L stainless steel or powder-coated aluminum: Recommended for high-alkali soils or humid areas to prevent accelerated corrosion ().
- o FRP trays: Suitable for chemical plants due to fireproofing and acid resistance ().
- o Minimum steel thickness: 1.5mm for structural safety ().
- o Fire rating: Class A for public buildings ().

Installation Procedure

- o Material Inspection and Storage: Inspect all trays, ladders, and accessories upon delivery. Store horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at 1-meter intervals, protected from moisture and sunlight ().
- o Review Shop Drawings: Confirm layout, tray lengths, and locations as per approved drawings ().
- o Support and Fixing:
 - o Ladder-type trays: support spacing ≤ 3 meters.
 - o Perforated trays: support spacing ≤ 2 meters ().
 - o Fix trays to steel structures, concrete, or pipe racks using standard steel shapes or self-drilling dowels ().
- o Tray Orientation: Preferably install trays flat under floors or walkways. Vertical or edgewise installation is allowed only in special cases ().
- o Cable Securing:
 - o Horizontal trays: secure cables in groups every 2-3 meters.
 - o Vertical trays: use 20mm stainless steel strips, two per meter ().

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- o Load Considerations: Design trays to carry 100kg/m ().
- o Grounding and Compliance: Ensure grounding continuity testing per IEC 61537 and compliance with ESA SES 501:2015 and ET-NFC 2015 fire codes ().
