

Classification Standards for Electrical Distribution Boxes at Moldova Construction Sites

Article Overview

Electrical distribution boxes on construction sites must be fireproof, weather-resistant, properly grounded, equipped with leakage protection, and installed according to safety and wiring standards.

Materials and Construction

Distribution boxes should be made of iron plate or fireproof insulating materials to ensure ventilation, heat dissipation, rainproofing, and fire resistance. Internal electrical components must be mounted on metal or insulating plates, with the metal base electrically connected to the box body for grounding purposes. Rubber-insulated cables are recommended for incoming and outgoing lines, with protective rings at cable entry points to prevent accidental contact with live parts .

Installation Requirements

- o Location: Install the box close to the power source to minimize power loss, in a dry, well-ventilated area, avoiding humid or corrosive environments .
- o Height: The bottom edge should be 1.5-1.8 meters above ground for easy operation and inspection .
- o Fixing: Use firm mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or collisions .
- o Sealing: Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are well-sealed to prevent dust and water ingress, with a recommended IP55 protection class for outdoor construction environments .

Electrical Components and Safety

- o Compatibility: The main distribution box's rated value and action settings must match those of branch switches .
- o Leakage Protection: Install earth leakage circuit breakers and follow the manufacturer's instructions for testing and maintenance .
- o Grounding: The metal box, electrical installation board, and internal appliances must be properly grounded, with the protective neutral wire reliably connected .
- o Wiring: Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load. Wiring should be standardized, with clear labeling and no exposed conductors .

Cables and Connectors

- o Use flexible, durable cables such as rubber cables or H07RN-F types suitable for outdoor construction conditions .

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- o Employ CEE plugs and sockets for robust, moisture- and dust-resistant connections, ensuring correct amperage and voltage ratings .
- o Avoid damaged or inferior cables and connectors, and ensure all connections are properly labeled and documented .

Compliance and Maintenance

- o Follow national standards for electrical components and protective devices .
- o Regularly inspect and test leakage protectors and other safety devices, recording results for compliance and safety assurance .
- o Ensure only authorized personnel remove covers or perform maintenance on the distribution box . By adhering to these requirements, construction sites in Moldova can maintain a safe, reliable, and efficient electrical distribution system, minimizing risks of electrocution, fire, and equipment downtime.
