The green light on a Switch typically indicates that the device is turned on and functioning properly. It may also denote that the Switch is connected to a power source and is ready for use. The

System activity and status can be determined through the activity of the LEDs on the switch. The status LEDs can display solid amber or flash during boot, POST, or other diagnostic tests.

Reason 1 The switch itself Please do a test: power on the switch---- use a good quality cable to connect two Ethernet ports (port 7 and port 5 for example, as shown below) on the switch

The Core controller has a status light on its front faceplate that indicates what condition the controller is currently reporting. The list below shows the possible status light LED's one would see when looking

Another reason the system is blinking green could be an outdated dock firmware. An outdated firmware for a Nintendo Switch dock with a LAN port causes the machine to blink green.

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
