Outdoor boxes are often fabricated from 2 mm galvanized iron (GI) sheet steel with reinforced channels for structural stability . Roofs are slightly slanted with overhangs to prevent water ingress, and doors feature concealed hinges and secure locking systems, such as Godrej 3-position locks, to enhance safety and security .

Material and Protection Standards

- o Material: GI sheet steel or high-quality insulating materials for indoor applications. Some boxes are glow-wire tested for fire resistance .
- o Protection Rating: Commonly IP-55, ensuring protection against dust and water jets .
- o Earthing: Solid earthing points on either side of the box for safety .
- o Corrosion Resistance: Galvanized or powder-coated finishes for outdoor durability .
