Overview

A distribution box houses multiple circuit breakers to manage and protect electrical circuits in residential, commercial, or industrial settings. An air leakage circuit breaker (also called an earth leakage or residual current breaker) is designed to detect leakage currents--small currents that escape to the ground due to insulation faults or moisture--and disconnect the circuit to prevent electric shock or fire .

Air Circuit Breaker (ACB) Function

An air circuit breaker (ACB) is a type of low-voltage breaker that uses air as the arc-extinguishing medium. It protects high-current circuits from overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults. ACBs are commonly installed in main distribution boards, switchboards, and motor control centers. They are often draw-out type, allowing easy maintenance and replacement without disconnecting the entire system . Key features of ACBs include:

- o High current capacity and adjustable protection settings
- o Arc quenching using air at atmospheric pressure
- o Robust construction for industrial and commercial applications
- o Ability to inspect, test, and maintain without full replacement

Earth Leakage Protection

Earth leakage circuit breakers (ELCBs) or residual current devices (RCDs) detect current leakage to the ground. When leakage exceeds a preset threshold (typically 30 mA for residential use), the breaker trips immediately, preventing electric shock and reducing fire risk . In a distribution box, combining an ACB with earth leakage protection ensures:

- o Protection against overcurrent and short circuits
- o Detection of ground faults or insulation failures
- o Enhanced safety for both equipment and personnel

Installation and Maintenance

- o Ensure the breaker is rated for the system voltage and current.
- o Connect the line and load terminals correctly; some ACBs allow reverse connection for flexibility .
- o Periodically test the earth leakage function using the test button to ensure proper operation.
- o Draw-out type ACBs allow easy maintenance by removing the breaker from its cradle without disconnecting the busbar .
