Proper wiring of a distribution box involves connecting the main power, circuit breakers, neutral, and earth wires according to safety standards and load requirements.

Main Power Connection

Start by connecting the incoming live (phase) wire to the main terminal or Main MCB (typically brown or red insulation) and the neutral wire to the neutral link in the distribution box . For single-phase domestic installations, a double-pole MCB is commonly used as the main switch, rated around 63A, while single-pole MCBs are used for individual output circuits .

Circuit Breaker Wiring

Insert the circuit breakers into their designated slots. Connect each branch circuit wire to the corresponding breaker, ensuring the phase wire goes to the breaker input and the neutral wire to the neutral link . For special loads, double-pole MCBs may be used for output circuits, connecting both phase and neutral wires from the RCCB output to the load MCB input .

Protective Devices

Install an RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) to protect against leakage currents, electrical shocks, and insulation faults. Connect the output of the Main MCB to the input of the RCCB, and then connect the output of the RCCB to the branch MCBs . Ensure the RCCB rating matches the main MCB, typically 30mA for domestic setups.

Earth and Safety Connections

Connect the earth wire from the supply or earth pit to the earth link in the box. Metallic parts of the distribution box should also be earthed . Ensure all wires are properly insulated, securely fastened, and neatly arranged using plastic ties to prevent tangling and allow heat dissipation .

Final Checks

After wiring, perform the following safety checks:

- o Insulation resistance test to verify no short circuits .
- o Circuit continuity test using a multimeter .
- o Confirm that all breakers, fuses, and protective devices are correctly installed and rated for the intended load

- o Clearly mark all wires for phase, neutral, and earth to avoid confusion during maintenance .

Tips for Safe Installation

- o Always cut off power before starting work.
- o Wear insulating gloves, safety glasses, and slip-resistant shoes .
- o Reserve space for heat dissipation and avoid sharp edges that may damage insulation.
- o Follow the wiring diagram specific to your distribution box type and load requirements .
