Standard PoE switches do not have storage for data; they function solely to transmit power and network traffic.

Function of a PoE Switch

A PoE switch is designed to deliver both electrical power and network connectivity to devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, wireless access points, and IoT devices through a single Ethernet cable, simplifying installation and reducing the need for separate power sources . It operates primarily at Layer 2 of the network, using MAC addresses to forward data between devices . Some managed PoE switches offer features like VLANs, QoS, and centralized power management, but these features rely on configuration memory rather than storage for user data .

Storage Capabilities

PoE switches do not include storage for files, logs, or applications in the way a server or NAS device would. They may have small amounts of volatile memory or flash memory to store configuration settings, firmware, and routing tables, but this is not considered general-purpose storage. Any data passing through the switch is transmitted in real time and is not retained on the device .

Exceptions

Some advanced network devices, such as PoE-enabled routers or security appliances, may include storage for logging or caching, but this is separate from the PoE switch functionality. A PoE switch itself remains a power and data distribution device, not a storage device.
