Eye chart tests, such as the Snellen chart, are standard tools to measure visual acuity and can be used at home or in a professional setting.

What is an Eye Chart Test?

An eye chart test evaluates how clearly you can see at a distance. The most common type is the Snellen chart, developed by Dutch ophthalmologist Hermann Snellen in the 1860s. It consists of rows of letters (optotypes) that decrease in size from top to bottom, usually starting with a large "E" at the top. Other variations include tumbling E charts for children or patients who cannot read letters, and symbol charts for pediatric use .

How to Perform a Home Eye Test

- o Distance Setup: Place the chart at the recommended distance--typically 20 feet (6 meters) for printed charts or 10 feet (3 meters) for on-screen charts .
- o One Eye at a Time: Cover one eye while reading the chart to test each eye individually .
- o Reading the Chart: Start from the top and read the smallest line you can see clearly. Record the line number and the number of letters correctly identified .
- o Interpreting Results: Visual acuity is expressed as a fraction, e.g., 20/20 means normal vision. Children and adults have different expected standards; for example, a 3- to 4-year-old should read the 20/40 line, while adults should read 20/20 .

Types of Eye Charts

- o Snellen Chart: Standard letters in decreasing size, most widely used .
- o Tumbling E Chart: Uses the letter "E" in different orientations, suitable for children or non-readers .
- o HOTV Chart: Uses letters H, O, T, V for young children, often with a matching guide .
- o Symbol Charts: Use shapes or images for pediatric patients .

Online and Printable Options

You can download and print eye charts from reputable sources or use online calibrated charts for informal vision screening. These tools are useful for preliminary checks at home, but they do not replace a professional eye exam .

- o Test each eye separately.
