Modern homes often use modular miniature circuit breakers (MCBs) for individual circuits. **Residual Current Devices (RCDs):** Also called residual current circuit breakers (RCCBs), these detect imbalances between live and neutral wires, protecting against electric shocks and leakage currents . **Fuses:** Older or supplementary protection devices that break the circuit when current exceeds a safe level. They require replacement after blowing but provide simple and reliable protection . **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that distribute power evenly to multiple circuits. They organize live, neutral, and earth connections, simplifying wiring and reducing energy loss . **Isolators:** Manually operated switches that allow sections of the electrical system to be safely disconnected for maintenance or emergencies . **Surge Protectors:** Optional devices that protect sensitive electronics from voltage spikes caused by lightning or power surges .
