



Fiber Optic Cable Bundling Costs

Material Costs

The price of fiber optic cables varies widely based on fiber type, strand count, and jacket construction. For bulk purchases, material costs can range from \$0.09 to \$1.52 per foot, while retail prices for standard cables range from \$1 to \$6 per foot. Simple single-core FTTH drop cables may cost around \$0.13 per foot, whereas high-count backbone cables (e.g., 288 strands) can reach \$6 per foot or more. Single-mode fiber is generally less expensive per foot than multimode fiber, but it requires more costly equipment for termination and testing.

For specialized applications, fiber optic bundles can be custom-configured with virtually any number of fibers, arranged in spot, line, grid, hex, or other patterns. End terminations can include standard connectors or custom ferrules, and jacket options can be tailored for indoor, outdoor, or industrial environments. Multimode fiber cores are available in diameters from 25 to 1800 um, with numerical apertures ranging from 0.10 to 0.37. Custom bundles are often used in spectroscopy, laser, and instrumentation applications, and pricing depends on the number of fibers, configuration, and additional components.

Installation and Project Costs

When including installation, labor, and ancillary components, the total cost per foot increases. Residential or small-business runs may see installation costs of \$2 to \$6 per foot, while larger projects with trenching, conduit, and splicing can range from \$11,000 to \$22,000 for several thousand feet of fiber. Factors affecting total cost include underground vs aerial installation, permits, protective ducting, and testing requirements.

Bulk and Wholesale Considerations

Pre-terminated assemblies and patch cables generally cost more due to factory termination and connectorization.
