Common Fiber Optic Connector Types

1. LC (Lucent Connector) LC connectors are small form-factor connectors with a 1.25 mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications such as data centers. They use a latch mechanism similar to RJ-style connectors, support both single-mode and multimode fibers, and are often mounted in duplex pairs for efficient port density. LC connectors are known for low insertion loss and high durability, making them suitable for modern high-speed networks . 2. SC (Subscriber Connector) SC connectors feature a square push-pull design with a 2.5 mm ferrule. They are widely used in FTTH deployments, data centers, and GPON networks. SC/APC variants provide low return loss, which is critical for RF video and high-performance optical systems . 3. ST (Straight Tip) ST connectors have a round shell with a bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism. They are commonly used in legacy systems, industrial networks, and fiber patch panels. ST connectors are valued for their robust mechanical connection, though they are less common in modern high-density networks . 4. FC (Ferrule Connector) FC connectors use a threaded coupling mechanism, providing secure connections in high-vibration environments such as factories, railway networks, and aviation systems. They are primarily used in single-mode fiber applications where stability and low signal loss are essential . 5. MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On) MPO and MTP connectors are high-density multi-fiber connectors designed to accommodate multiple fibers (8, 12, or 24) in a single interface. They are widely used in data centers, high-speed computing, and telecom networks to maximize space efficiency, support parallel connections, and reduce installation time . 6. Other Types Additional connectors include MU, E2000, PC, UPC, and APC, which vary in ferrule size, polishing type, and coupling mechanism. These are often used in specialized applications requiring precise alignment, low insertion loss, or high return loss performance .

- o Single-Fiber vs. Multi-Fiber: Single-fiber connectors (LC, SC, ST, FC) are used for point-to-point connections, while multi-fiber connectors (MPO/MTP) support high-density parallel connections.
- o Polishing Types: Connectors may have UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) polishing to reduce reflection and improve signal quality.
- o Application Environment: Choice depends on network density, vibration exposure, and required optical performance. Choosing the right fiber optic connector ensures low insertion loss, high reliability, and compatibility with network equipment, making it a critical factor in optical network design .
