- o Burying depth: Typically 18-24 inches for direct burial fiber, or follow local codes .
- o Conduit: Use PVC or HDPE conduit to protect the fiber from moisture, rodents, and mechanical stress .
- o Bend management: Avoid tight bends; maintain the manufacturer's minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage .
- o Labeling and testing: Label both ends of the fiber and test with an OTDR or light source/power meter to verify signal integrity .

- o Distance and signal loss: Multi-mode fiber is suitable for shorter distances; single-mode is better for long
