Signal Interference: Nearby Wi-Fi networks, Bluetooth devices, or other electronics can interfere with your connection, especially on 2.4 GHz bands .

- o Restart Your Router: Power cycling your router can clear temporary glitches and restore full speed .
- o Upgrade Your Router: Consider a modern router that supports gigabit speeds and Wi-Fi 6 (802.11ax) for better performance and future-proofing .
- o Optimize Router Placement: Place the router in a central, elevated location, away from walls, metal objects, and electronics. Avoid closets or storage rooms .
- o Reduce Network Congestion: Limit simultaneous high-bandwidth activities or schedule heavy downloads for off-peak hours. Use Quality of Service (QoS) settings if available .
- o Check Cables and Connections: Replace damaged or outdated cables and ensure all connections are secure. For multi-room setups, consider running Ethernet to key devices instead of relying solely on Wi-Fi .
- o Update Devices: Ensure all devices have updated network drivers and firmware to fully utilize your fiber speeds . By systematically addressing these factors, you can significantly improve your fiber optic internet performance and reduce slowdowns, ensuring reliable speeds for streaming, gaming, and video conferencing.
