FTTH routers connect directly to a fiber-optic line in your home, providing ultra-fast internet with integrated modems and advanced Wi-Fi capabilities.

Understanding FTTH

FTTH (Fiber To The Home) delivers a direct fiber-optic connection to your residence, enabling download speeds up to 1,000 Mbit/s or higher, far exceeding traditional DSL or VDSL connections . Unlike FTTB (Fiber To The Building), where fiber ends at the building and copper wiring continues to individual apartments, FTTH terminates the fiber directly at a wall socket in your home, allowing maximum bandwidth and minimal signal loss . To use FTTH, a fiber-optic outlet (Gf-TA) is installed, which connects to your router or modem .

Router Options for FTTH

1. Telekom Speedport 7

- o Integrated GPON fiber modem: Connects directly to the FTTH socket without needing a separate modem .
- o Wi-Fi 7 support: Provides ultra-fast wireless speeds up to 6,760 Mbit/s, ideal for streaming, gaming, and home office use .
- o Mesh capability: Can be expanded with up to 5 additional mesh points for full home coverage .
- o Dual-band operation: 2.4 GHz (up to 1,000 Mbit/s) and 5 GHz (up to 5,760 Mbit/s) for optimized performance .
- o Smart Home integration: Built-in Magenta SmartHome base for connected devices .
- o Availability: Can be rented for EUR7.95/month or purchased outright for EUR229.99 .

- o Models like Fritz!Box 5530 Fiber, 5590 Fiber, and 5690 include integrated fiber modems.
- o Support high-speed Wi-Fi and mesh networking.

Setup and Connectivity

FTTH routers are typically connected as follows:

- o Fiber-optic outlet (Gf-TA) installed in your home.
- o Router with integrated fiber modem plugged into the outlet.
- o Optional: Mesh nodes or Wi-Fi extenders to expand coverage in larger homes . Some setups may still use a

separate fiber modem plus a Wi-Fi router, but modern devices like the Speedport 7 or Fritz!Box Fiber combine both functions, simplifying installation and management .
