To prevent linear twisting, side-rail deflection, or rung deformation under dynamic load stresses, a heavy-duty ladder cable tray thickness between 2.0mm is strongly recommended. This thick sheet metal layout ensures optimal structural rigidity and long-term system. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements --width, depth, length, and material thickness--that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. Aluminum trays have a lower weight and can be installed more easily, but may require the supports to be closer to support the same weight.
