

How to connect a fiber optic cable tray connector

Connecting Fiber Tray Components

Fiber optic cable trays are typically connected by inserting each tray component into a coupler and pushing until fully seated. Ensure that both components are flush against the center divider of the coupler, then secure them using the appropriate number of thumb screws or fasteners provided in the tray system . End caps are installed with brackets on the outside of the tray to protect the fiber ends and maintain alignment.

Securing Fiber Cables in Trays

Maintaining Bend Radius and Fiber Protection

Each tray has a minimum bend radius (commonly 3 inches or 76.2 mm) that must be maintained to prevent signal loss or fiber breakage . Fibers should be looped following the molded arrows in the tray base, typically completing at least one full circle. Protective covers or clear tray lids allow visual inspection of splices and fiber routing while keeping fibers secure.

Splice Trays and Breakout Kits

For fiber splicing, splice trays are used to organize and protect individual fibers. Transport tubes or breakout kits may be required to transition fiber bundles to the tray, ensuring proper routing and strain relief . Fibers are secured with cable ties or vinyl tape, avoiding excessive pressure that could damage the fibers.

- o Use figure-8 loops when laying fiber to prevent twisting .
- o Avoid sharp bends, edges, or mechanical stress points.
- o Ensure all fasteners are finger-tightened first, then fully secured to maintain alignment .
- o Plan for future expansion by leaving adequate space in trays and couplers.
