

How to connect rack fiber optic patch cords

- o Secure and Organize: Use Velcro straps or cable ties to bundle excess cable length without over-tightening. Keep fibers organized to prevent tangling and maintain airflow in the rack .
- o Test the Connection: After connecting, verify the optical signal using a power meter or OTDR to ensure low loss and proper connectivity .

- o Regularly inspect connectors for dust or damage and clean with fiber optic cleaning tools.
- o Keep documentation of port assignments and cable routes for easier troubleshooting.
