

How to find fiber optic connections for many routers

Routers do not directly connect to fiber optic cables; instead, they connect to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) that converts fiber signals into Ethernet for the router.

How Fiber Internet Connects to a Router

Fiber optic internet delivers data as light pulses through ultra-thin glass strands, which cannot be directly processed by standard routers. To use fiber at home, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed by your ISP. The ONT converts the optical signals into electrical signals via an Ethernet port, which then connects to your router's WAN port . Some ISPs provide a combined ONT and router unit, but in most cases, the ONT and router are separate devices .

Fiber-Ready Routers

A fiber router is specifically designed to handle high-speed fiber connections. While it does not plug directly into the fiber cable, it is optimized to work with the ONT and can support gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds, low latency, and high bandwidth demands . Features of fiber routers often include:

- o Multiple gigabit Ethernet ports and sometimes 10G LAN/WAN ports
- o Support for Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 for high-speed wireless coverage
- o Advanced security features like firewalls and VPN support
- o LAN aggregation to combine ports for faster wired speeds
