

How to install an electricity meter inside a distribution box

Installing an electricity meter in a distribution box requires careful planning, proper wiring, grounding, and adherence to safety standards to ensure a safe and compliant electrical setup.

Preparation and Safety

- o Middle Layer: Mount the main circuit breaker below the outgoing line of the meter. Connect the meter's outgoing wires to the main breaker following the principle of "incoming from the upper part and outgoing from the lower part" .
- o Lower Layer: Install branch circuit breakers for lighting, sockets, and appliances. Connect the outgoing line from the main breaker to the incoming terminals of the branch breakers .
- o Grounding and Neutral: Connect the ground busbar to the box body and ground wire, and the neutral busbar to all neutral wires centrally .

Wiring Steps

- o Incoming Line End: Connect L1 (phase), N (neutral), and PE (ground) from the utility supply to the meter and busbars .
- o Outgoing Line End: Connect L1 and N from the meter to the main breaker, then distribute to branch breakers .
- o Ensure all connections are torqued properly and wires are neatly routed with enough slack for maintenance .
- o Seal the box against weather if installed outdoors, using proper cable glands and door seals .

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Final Checks

- o Verify all connections, grounding, and breaker positions.
- o Label circuits clearly for easy identification.
- o Test the system with a voltage tester before energizing.
- o Schedule a utility inspection before turning on the main supply .

Important Notes

- o Installation should ideally be performed or supervised by a licensed electrician due to the risks of handling live wires and compliance requirements .
