

How to make quick connectors for fiber optic cables

- o Check Alignment and Performance: Inspect the fiber end for proper alignment and minimal bending. Ensure the connector meets return loss and insertion loss requirements (e.g., UPC $\geq 40\text{dB}$, APC $\geq 55\text{dB}$), .

- o Always use connectors compatible with the fiber type and core size.
- o Avoid sharp bends or excessive tension in the fiber during installation.
- o Practice on spare fibers to improve speed and accuracy.
- o For high-density or reversible polarity setups, consider LC uniboot connectors for easier management .
