

How to plug the optical module into the switch

To safely install an optical module, align it correctly with the switch port, insert it gently until it clicks, and then connect the fiber cable while following ESD and laser safety precautions.

Step-by-Step Installation

1. Prepare for Installation

- o Power off the switch if recommended by the manufacturer to prevent electrical damage, though some modules support hot-swapping .
- o Ground yourself using an ESD wrist strap or touch a grounded metal surface to prevent electrostatic discharge that can damage the module .
- o Ensure the optical module is compatible with your switch and certified for use to maintain transmission reliability .

2. Handle the Module Carefully

- o Avoid touching the edge connector of the module to prevent contamination .
- o Keep dust plugs on the module and switch port until ready to connect .
- o Never look directly into the module or fiber ends, as laser radiation can cause eye damage .

3. Insert the Module

- o Remove the dust plug from the switch port.
- o Align the module with the port, ensuring the metal connectors match the slot.
- o Gently push the module into the port until you hear a click, indicating it is securely seated .
- o If the module does not fit, do not force it; turn it 180 degrees and try again .

4. Connect the Fiber Cable

- o Only connect the fiber after the module is fully inserted.
- o Ensure the fiber type matches the module (multi-mode with multi-mode, single-mode with single-mode) to avoid transmission issues .

5. Verify Installation

- o Keep connectors clean and dust-free to maintain signal quality and prevent attenuation .
- ### 6. Maintenance and Safety
- o Check the module's LED indicators; a green light usually indicates proper operation .
 - o Use switch commands to confirm the port recognizes the module and the link is active .
 - o Measure optical power if necessary to ensure it is within the module's specified range .

- o Keep unused ports covered with dust plugs.
 - o Avoid repeated insertions and removals to extend module life .
 - o Regularly clean connectors and inspect for damage to maintain reliable network performance .
