

# How to unplug the SC fiber optic connector

## Article Overview

To safely unplug an SC fiber optic connector, gently press the release tab and pull the connector straight out without bending the fiber.

## Step-by-Step Procedure

- o **Power Down Equipment** Ensure all connected devices are powered off to prevent signal disruption or damage to the fiber optic system .
- o **Wear Protective Gear** Use safety glasses to protect your eyes from potential fiber shards and latex or nitrile gloves to prevent oils from contaminating the fiber ends .
- o **Identify the Connector** SC connectors are square-shaped with a push-pull design. Locate the release tab on the connector body .
- o **Clear the Area** Make sure the surrounding area is clean and free of dust. Contamination can degrade signal quality .
- o **Release the Connector** Press the release tab on the SC connector gently. Avoid twisting or forcing the connector, as this can damage the ferrule or fiber .
- o **Pull Straight Out** While holding the release tab, pull the connector straight out from the adapter or port. Do not bend or kink the fiber cable, as sharp bends can break the fiber or reduce performance .
- o **Cap the Connector** Immediately place a protective dust cap on the unplugged connector to prevent contamination and scratches on the ferrule .
- o **Inspect and Clean if Necessary** Before reconnecting, inspect the ferrule for dirt or debris. Clean with a lint-free wipe moistened with >91% isopropyl alcohol if needed, wiping from wet to dry to avoid scratches .

## Additional Tips

- o Avoid excessive force; SC connectors are designed for easy push-pull operation.
- o Never twist the connector while unplugging.
- o Keep fiber cables supported to prevent stress on the connector.
- o Use a fiber optic cleaning kit to maintain optimal signal performance . Following these steps ensures that SC fiber optic connectors are unplugged safely, preserving both the fiber and the network performance.
