- o Splicing and Organization: Use fusion splicing or mechanical splicing to join fibers as needed. Organize fibers neatly within the box to prevent bending or stress, which can cause signal loss .
- o Testing: Power on the network devices and use a fiber optic tester to verify signal quality, bandwidth, and connectivity. Ensure minimal back reflection and low signal attenuation .

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- o Follow local Telco operator guidelines for FTTH installations in Portugal to ensure compliance and network reliability .
- o Use high-quality, impact-resistant materials for outdoor boxes, with IP65 or IP68 ratings for dust and water protection .
- o Maintain proper bend radius and fiber management to prevent signal degradation .
