

Installation of Main Distribution Box Specifications

A main distribution box should be installed in a dry, accessible location with proper enclosure, grounding, circuit protection, and compliance with electrical standards.

Site Selection and Placement

Enclosure Specifications

Check the IP or NEMA rating: higher ratings (e.g., IP66, IP67, or IP69K) are required for outdoor or washdown locations .

Internal Components

- o Main switch or main breaker: controls the entire electrical supply and allows emergency disconnection .

- o Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are properly sealed to maintain environmental protection .
- o Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on .

Compliance and Maintenance

- o Follow local and international standards such as NEC, IEC, or regional codes .
- o Use UL/CE-certified components and maintain installation records for inspections .
- o Schedule regular maintenance and inspections to ensure long-term reliability .
- o Consider modular designs for easier future upgrades .
