

Installing the Fiber Optic Router Card

To install a fiber optic router card, power down the device, handle the card and transceivers with ESD precautions, insert the card into an appropriate slot, connect fiber transceivers, and verify connectivity.

Preparation and Safety

- o **Power Down and Disconnect:** Ensure the router or server is powered off and unplugged from AC power to prevent electrical hazards and damage to components .
- o **ESD Protection:** Wear an ESD-preventative wrist strap connected to a grounded point. Handle the card by its edges and avoid touching connector pins or circuitry .

Direct-attach cables (DAC) or active optical cables (AOC) can be used for very short connections .

Post-Installation Steps

- o **Reconnect Power and Boot:** Power on the device and ensure the system recognizes the new card. For servers, check with `lspci` or `ethtool -i` on Linux, or Device Manager on Windows .
- o **Install Drivers/Firmware:** Load the vendor-provided drivers and firmware updates to ensure full functionality and compatibility .
- o **Test Connectivity:** Verify the link with a connected partner device using ping tests, iperf, or other network diagnostic tools. Ensure signal quality and speed meet expectations .
- o **Monitor Temperature and Performance:** High-speed dual-port cards can generate heat. Ensure proper airflow and cooling to maintain performance .

Additional Tips

- o Avoid bending fiber cables sharply; maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent damage.
- o Keep transceiver dust caps on until ready to connect.

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- o For modular routers, follow manufacturer-specific guidelines for line card insertion and removal to prevent chassis damage or misalignment .
- o Use the management port (MGMT ETH) for initial configuration before connecting the main network interfaces to avoid IP conflicts . By following these steps, you can safely install a fiber optic router card, maintain signal integrity, and ensure reliable high-speed network connectivity.
