Function and Purpose

Wiring and Connections

- o Live (L) Wire: The incoming live wire connects to the line terminal of the breaker or distribution port, serving as the primary energy source .
- o Neutral (N) Wire: Depending on the system, the neutral may bypass the breaker (1P) or be switched along with live wires (2P) .
- o Protective Earth (PE): Must be connected to the ground busbar to ensure safety against earth faults .
- o EPS Ports: In hybrid inverter systems, EPS cables are connected to designated ports with proper stripping, crimping, and torque specifications to ensure secure connections .
- o Grid Ports: Connect the parallel box to the main grid distribution box, typically requiring R, S, T, N, and G cables .

Safety Considerations

- o Always disconnect all power sources before maintenance or installation .
- o Use cables of appropriate size and quality; avoid damaged or substandard wires .
- o Follow manufacturer guidelines for torque and terminal connections to prevent loose contacts and high-voltage hazards .
- o Observe local wiring codes, such as AS/NZS 3000:2012 for Australia and New Zealand, which may dictate whether neutral lines must remain connected or switched .

- o Channel Configurations: Distribution boxes may offer multiple channels (4, 6, 8, 10, 12) with staggered or wide-spaced jacks .
- o Interface Types: Options include M8, M12, M23, direct cable outlets, terminal connections, or multi-core
