

Maximum length of wall-mounted fiber optic cable installation

Basic guidelines that can be applied to any type of cable installation are as follows: Conduct a thorough site survey prior to cable placement. Do not exceed cable maximum recommended load. The shorter distance accounts for the lower tensile strength and the need for gentle handling to avoid damage to the delicate fibers.

Fiber optic cable may be installed indoors or outdoors using several different installation processes. Outdoor cable may be direct buried, pulled or blown into

Fiber optic cable sequential numbers are required at each pole location and vault wall. Sequential numbers will identify conduit length, and slack left in vaults and at poles.

Most optical fibre cables can be installed in vertical situations without any issues arising. In tall buildings like TV towers with a height of max. 650 m, our experience shows that no filling compound will drip

Although most fiber optic cables are not conductive, any metallic hardware used in fiber optic cabling systems (such as wall-mounted termination boxes, racks, and patch panels) must be grounded.

While fiber optic cables are typically stronger than copper cables, it is still important that the cable maximum pulling tension not be exceeded during any phase of cable installation.
