The thickness standard for galvanized (steel) Cable Trays is based on GB/T 14540-2020 "Cable Trays" (the latest national standard) and JB/T 10216-2013 "Cable Trays for Electrical Control and Distribution" (industry standard). The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) Standards and guideline publications, of which the document herein is one, are developed through a voluntary Standards development process.
