The standard wall thickness for secondary distribution boxes in North Asia generally ranges from 1.5mm to 2.0mm for steel enclosures, with back panels often requiring 3.0mm for structural integrity.

Standard Thickness Guidelines

- o Low-voltage distribution boxes: The wall thickness should not be less than 1.5mm, typically made from cold-rolled steel, stainless steel, or aluminum plates to ensure durability, heat resistance, and safety .
- o Metal auxiliary poles or internal mounting structures: Usually 1.2mm minimum thickness .
- o Larger boxes ($\geq 600\text{mm}$): Often require 2.0mm thick cold-rolled steel plates for the main body, while smaller boxes (
