Understanding the Role of Neutral and Ground

In AC electrical systems, the neutral conductor carries current under normal operation, while the ground conductor is primarily for safety, providing a path to earth in case of faults. The neutral is typically bonded to earth at the service entrance or transformer, but it is not directly connected to overhead ground wires or optical fibers. This separation ensures that fault currents do not travel through communication fibers, which could damage equipment or pose safety hazards.

Optical Cables in Power Systems

Fiber optic cables integrated with power lines include:

- o OPGW (Optical Ground Wire): Combines optical fibers with a metallic ground wire, installed at the top of transmission towers for lightning protection and communication.
- o OPPC (Optical Power Phase Conductor): Combines optical fibers with phase conductors, carrying both power and communication signals.
- o OPAC (Optical Power Attached Cable): A dielectric fiber optic cable wrapped around existing conductors to expand communication capacity. These cables are dielectric or metallic, but the optical fibers themselves are immune to electrical currents. Metallic components, if present, are grounded to the substation ground grid or tower structures, not to the transformer neutral.

Grounding and Bonding Practices

- o Metallic components of fiber cables (e.g., steel armor or strength members) are bonded to the grounding system to dissipate electrostatic charges and protect against lightning or transient voltages.
- o OPGW and OPPC cables are tied to the substation ground grid at line ends, while the neutral of the transformer is connected to the ground grid through its own impedance, maintaining electrical safety.
- o Dielectric fibers do not carry current and do not require a direct connection to neutral or ground, but proper bonding of metallic parts ensures system protection.
