



No internet even with the telecom fiber optic router

Article Overview

If your fiber optic router shows connectivity but you have no internet, the issue could be due to ISP problems, router configuration, or physical connections.

Check Basic Connections

Ensure all fiber optic cables are securely connected and undamaged. Look for visible bends, cuts, or loose connectors, and clean connectors with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol if necessary . Verify that the Ethernet cable from the modem to your router is properly plugged into the WAN or internet port .

Power Cycle Devices

Restart both your modem and router. Unplug them from the power source, wait about a minute, then reconnect and allow a few minutes for them to fully boot . This can resolve temporary glitches.

Verify Router Settings

Some fiber connections require a PPPoE username and password to access the internet. Check if your ISP has provided these credentials. If not, contact your ISP to obtain them, as the connection may not establish without proper authentication . Ensure your router firmware is up to date, as outdated firmware can cause connectivity issues .

Test Device and Network

Check if other devices in your home can connect to the internet. If only one device is affected, the problem may be with that device rather than the network . For wireless issues, try connecting a device directly via Ethernet to determine if the problem is with Wi-Fi or the internet connection itself.

Check for ISP or Local Outages

Sometimes the issue is external. Visit your ISP's service status page or use real-time outage trackers like Downdetector to see if there are known problems in your area .

Additional Steps

- o Reset network settings on your devices if necessary.
- o Avoid interference from new electrical devices that may affect broadband performance .
