- o **Proper Conductor Sizing:** Match wire gauge to load requirements to avoid overloading circuits .
- o **Neat Cable Management:** Arrange wires to allow heat dissipation and easy maintenance. Use cable ties or ducts for organization .
- o **Breaker Placement:** Place high-power breakers (ovens, water heaters, EV chargers) near the main input, and low-power breakers (lights, alarms) further along the busbar to manage heat effectively .
