

PoE switches have built-in power supply

Yes, PoE switches have built-in power supplies that deliver both data and electrical power over Ethernet cables to connected devices.

How PoE Switches Work

A PoE (Power over Ethernet) switch functions as both a network switch and a power source. It injects electrical power into Ethernet cables, allowing connected devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, wireless access points, and IoT devices to receive both data connectivity and power from a single cable . This eliminates the need for separate power adapters, reducing cable clutter and simplifying installation .

Built-In Power Supply

The built-in power supply in a PoE switch converts AC power from the mains into DC power, which is then transmitted through the Ethernet cables to powered devices (PDs) according to IEEE standards such as 802.3af, 802.3at, and 802.3bt . Active PoE switches detect the connected device and determine its power requirements before supplying the appropriate voltage and current, ensuring safe and efficient power delivery . Passive PoE switches or injectors, in contrast, do not perform this detection and supply a fixed voltage.

Power Classes and Standards

PoE switches are classified based on the power they can deliver per port:

- o PoE (IEEE 802.3af): up to 15.4W per port, typically 12.95W available to the device
- o PoE+ (IEEE 802.3at): up to 30W per port, typically 25.5W to the device
- o PoE++ / 4PPoE (IEEE 802.3bt): up to 60W or 100W per port, depending on the type, using all four pairs in the Ethernet cable The total power capacity of the switch determines how many devices it can power simultaneously.

Benefits of Built-In Power

Having a built-in power supply in PoE switches provides several advantages:

- o Centralized power management: easier monitoring and troubleshooting of connected devices
- o Simplified installation: no need for separate power outlets near each device
- o Flexibility: devices can be installed in ceilings, outdoor locations, or remote areas without dedicated power sources
