FastFiber is the largest fiber optic wholesale operator in Portugal, providing access to its Passive Optical Network (PON) infrastructure. Their network supports passive dark fiber with splitting, enabling operators to deploy advanced broadband solutions efficiently and scale connectivity across multiple users and locations . Altice Labs specializes in innovative ICT solutions with a strong focus on optical technologies, including Optical Distribution Networks. While primarily a research and development company, Altice Labs contributes to the design and deployment of PON systems in Portugal, supporting high-speed broadband and network management solutions . Other Portuguese companies like NEWVISION and Instituto de Telecomunicacoes (IT) focus on optical technologies and telecommunications research, which may indirectly support PON development through R&D and advanced optical components .

OSFP Technology Overview

OSFP (Octal Small Form Factor Pluggable) is an open standard for high-speed optical transceivers, designed for 400G, 800G, and 1.6T Ethernet applications. OSFP modules support 8 electrical lanes per module, each capable of 50-200G PAM4 signaling, providing scalable bandwidth for data centers and high-performance networks . OSFP modules are available in passive and active variants, with integrated thermal management to handle high power dissipation (up to 30W for OSFP1600), making them suitable for dense, high-speed optical networks . While OSFP is widely adopted in hyperscale and cloud environments, it can also be integrated into PON systems where high-speed aggregation or interconnects are required.

Integration Potential

Although no Portuguese manufacturer currently lists OSFP modules specifically for PON, FastFiber's PON infrastructure could potentially leverage OSFP-based transceivers from global vendors like Amphenol or TE Connectivity to enhance backbone or aggregation links. This combination allows Portuguese operators to deploy high-capacity, future-proof optical networks while maintaining compatibility with international OSFP standards .
