o Sub-circuit wiring: 1.5mm²-2.5mm² for lighting, 2.5mm²-4mm² for sockets, and 4mm²-6mm² for high-power appliances. Average cost per meter is \$1-\$3 .

o Protective Devices

o MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers): \$5-\$20 each depending on rating.

o RCCB/RCD (Residual Current Device): \$20-\$80 each.

o Bus bars, isolators, and fuses: \$10-\$50 depending on configuration .

o Labor Costs

o Electrician charges vary by region but typically range from \$50-\$100 per hour.
