

Repair of the beam splitter

Repair procedure: We require the metal beamsplitter mounts (frame). Beamsplitters separate incident light into two or more beams of the same wavelength. These exiting beams are differentiated by either their optical power (non-polarizing) or polarization states (polarizing). Beamsplitters are often classified according to their construction: cube or plate. Does anyone know of a source of right angle beam splitters?
