The Eastern Bloc, also known as the Communist Bloc (Combloc), the Soviet Bloc, the Socialist Bloc and the Workers Bloc, was an unofficial coalition of communist states of Central and Eastern Europe, Asia, Africa, and Latin America that were aligned with the Soviet Union and existed during the Cold. As Allied cooperation gave way to rivalry between the United States and the Soviet Union under Joseph Stalin (rule 1924-1953), the continent became divided into competing spheres of.
