What Causes a Short Circuit

Short circuits happen when electrical conductors, usually live and neutral wires, touch each other directly or through a faulty appliance, bypassing the normal load. Common causes include:

- o Damaged or old wiring with deteriorated insulation
- o Loose connections at terminals or switches
- o Faulty appliances plugged into the circuit
- o External damage from nails, screws, or pests chewing wires
- o Overloaded circuits or improper modifications to the wiring

Symptoms of a Short Circuit

Signs that a short circuit has occurred in your distribution box include:

- o Sudden power outage in one or more rooms
- o Sparks or burning smell near outlets or the distribution box
- o Tripped circuit breakers or blown fuses immediately after turning on a device

Steps to Identify and Resolve

- o Turn off the main switch to de-energize the entire electrical system for safety .
- o Check individual circuits by turning off all breakers and RCDs, then switching them on one by one to locate the faulty circuit .
- o Disconnect all devices on the suspected circuit to ensure the short is not caused by an appliance .
- o Inspect wiring, outlets, and switches for melted spots, discoloration, or loose connections .
- o Use a multimeter to check for current flow and confirm the location of the fault .
- o Repair or replace damaged wires or components once the short circuit is identified .

Safety Considerations

- o Always de-energize circuits before inspection.
- o Avoid touching exposed wires or terminals.
- o If unsure, contact a certified electrician to prevent fire or electrocution .
