Bolt all section frames together and connect all through bus and ground bus at shipping breaks using the splice plate bus and hardware supplied. Tighten bolted connections in accordance with torque

Distribution Boxes shall have Isolator (Switch Disconnecter) on incoming circuit and Porcelain CUTOUT fuse base disconnecter on outgoing circuits with necessary interconnecting Bus Bars.
