A 40G Active Optical Device is typically a QSFP+ (Quad Small Form-Factor Pluggable) module or cable that converts electrical signals into optical signals for high-speed data transmission. These devices are widely used in data centers, enterprise networks, and high-performance computing environments in Tanzania .

o 40G QSFP to QSFP AOC

- o Provides 40Gb/s aggregated bandwidth using 4 full-duplex lanes at 10Gb/s each.

- o Supports high-density 40GbE to 10GbE breakout applications .

o 40G QSFP+ Transceiver Modules

- o Includes SR4, LR4, CSR4, IR4, and BIDI types.
- o Operates over single-mode or multimode fiber with distances ranging from 150 meters to 40 km depending on module type.
- o Suitable for 40G Ethernet or Optical Transport Network (OTU3) applications .
