Three principles can be sitive. 0-10V dimming is an analog low-voltage control method where a 0-10V DC signal adjusts LED driver output from 0% (off or minimum) to 100% (full brightness). It requires two extra low-voltage wires (violet/gray, 18 AWG Class 1) between the dimmer and each LED driver. Wire runs up to 150 ft with. In order to dim the intensity of a light bulb, the flow of current is reduced, which corresponds to a regulation of the brightness. The systems are predictable and reliable and generally require minimal maintenance. A complete 0-10V dimming control system includes a control interface, one or more light fixtures that support 0-10V dimming and a dedicated control wire pair that connects the 0-10V. This function is commonly referred to as dimming control. Many devices, like TI's TPS92515 or LM3409 LED drivers, have a dedicated analog dimming pin with which to adjust the internal sense voltage.
