

Two fiber optic cables connected to the router

- o Direct Router Connection:
 - o Insert each fiber cable into the router's SFP ports using compatible transceivers.
 - o Ensure the transmit (TX) and receive (RX) ends are correctly aligned for duplex communication .
- o Connecting Two Routers via Fiber:
 - o Use a duplex fiber cable between the SFP ports of each router.
 - o Configure IP addresses and routing appropriately, often using point-to-point subnets to manage traffic between routers .
 - o Ensure both routers' SFP modules are compatible with the fiber type and distance.
- o Splicing or Extending Fiber:
 - o If you need to join two fiber cables, use fusion splicing for a permanent, low-loss connection or mechanical splicing for a temporary connection .
 - o This is typically done by trained technicians to maintain signal integrity.

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Best Practices

- o Always use pre-manufactured fiber patch cables to avoid alignment issues .
- o Verify that the wavelength and fiber type match the transceivers and router specifications.
- o Keep fiber cables clean and free of dust to prevent signal loss.
- o For multiple routers sharing a single fiber connection, consider using a high-speed switch and separate IP addresses for each router .
