- o Duplex LC: Connects two fibers for full-duplex communication (transmit and receive). Common in data centers and enterprise networks ().

3. Based on Fiber Type

- o Single-mode LC: Optimized for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications.
- o Multimode LC: Used for shorter distances, such as within buildings or campus networks ().

Additional Considerations

- o Insertion Loss: Typically around 0.25 dB.
- o Mating Cycles: Rated for up to 500 connections.
- o High-Density Applications: LC connectors are preferred in environments where port density is critical, such as QSFP-DD or SFP-DD transceivers ().
