Common Types of Fiber Optic Cold Connectors

1. SC (Subscriber Connector)

- o Square-shaped with a push-pull latching system.
- o Ferrule diameter: 2.5 mm, usually ceramic.
- o Polishing options: UPC (flat) and APC (angled, 8°) for low reflection.
- o Applications: FTTH, telecom backbone, and PON systems where low return loss is critical.

2. LC (Lucent Connector)

- o Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25 mm ferrule.
- o Uses a latch mechanism similar to RJ45 plugs.
- o Ideal for high-density applications in data centers and duplex/simplex configurations.
- o Compatible with both single-mode and multimode fibers.

3. ST (Straight Tip)

- o Bayonet-style twist-lock mechanism.
- o Ferrule diameter: 2.5 mm.
- o Primarily used in legacy systems, industrial, and military networks.

4. FC (Ferrule Connector)

- o Threaded coupling for secure connections in high-vibration environments.
- o Ferrule diameter: 2.5 mm, precision ceramic.
- o Applications: factories, railway networks, aviation, DWDM systems, and RF-over-fiber setups.

5. MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push On / Multi-Fiber Termination Push-On)

- o Multi-fiber connectors capable of connecting up to 24 fibers in a single ferrule.
- o Uses metal guide pins for precise alignment.
- o Ideal for high-density, high-bandwidth applications in data centers and industrial environments.
